



IMPORTANT: MEETING OF CREDITORS NOTICE

Dear Creditor,

The Office of the U. S. Trustee has scheduled meetings of creditors in the PFI and PISF bankruptcy cases, to be held on Tuesday, August 25. The PFI meeting is scheduled for 10:30 a.m. and the PISF meeting is scheduled for 1:00 p.m. **Because the companies are interrelated, information covered during the PFI meeting of creditors may be relevant to all creditors of both companies and we therefore encourage you to make every effort to attend the PFI meeting at 10:30 a.m. even if you are only a creditor of PISF.** If you are a PISF creditor and are unable to attend the PFI meeting at 10:30 a.m., please still attend the PISF meeting at 1:00 p.m.

These meetings of creditors are required by Bankruptcy Code section 341(a) and will be presided over by a representative of the U.S. Trustee's Office. Creditors are not required to attend and you will lose no rights if you do not attend. The meetings of creditors are an opportunity for creditors and the U.S. Trustee to receive information from the debtors (PFI and PISF) and to ask questions of the debtors. The meeting will be remote via telephone, with connectivity information provided in the attached documents filed by the U.S. Trustee's Office.

How to Connect

PLEASE FOLLOW the instructions below from the U.S. Trustee's Office to ensure a smooth and efficient telephonic section 341 meeting of creditors.

- You must use a touch-tone phone.
- If you have a choice, use a landline phone, instead of a cell phone.
- Dial the call-in number, **1-888-810-3947**, and then enter the passcode **7708434**, followed by a # sign.
- Make the call from a quiet area where there is as little background noise as possible.
- Mute your phone and do not speak until the U.S Trustee counsel asks you to identify yourself or indicates you may ask questions. You will still be able to listen even when your phone is muted.
- Unmute your phone when speaking.
- When speaking, identify yourself.
- Do not put the phone on hold at any time after the call is connected.
- Once the meeting of creditors is finished, please hang up.
- If you become disconnected before the meeting is finished, please call back.
- The section 341 meeting of creditors will be recorded by the U.S. Trustee. Any other recordings are prohibited.
- **Neither the U.S. Trustee nor the Debtors may provide legal advice to any creditors.**
